ARROYO NOTIFICATION

Lower Arroyo Habitat Restoration Project

On September 17th, from 5- 6 p.m. Councilmember Madison will host a virtual meeting on the Lower Arroyo Habitat Restoration Project that is scheduled to begin construction by January 2021 and be complete by March 30, 2021 as mandated by the grant. This is a project that has been in the capital budget since 2020 and implements a portion of the Lower Arroyo Master Plan. Specifically this project provides habitat restoration within the vicinity of the Van De Kamp Bridge. During this meeting Public Works staff will present the project in more detail and be available to answer questions.

Prior to this meeting the project will be presented to the Recreation and Parks Commission on September 1st and then to UFAC on September 9th for **conceptual approval**.

If you walk the area, note that the trees that are destined for removal are tied with a light colored ribbon.

This project is funded by Los Angeles County grant funds and has a tight schedule which is why staff will go to these commissions prior to the community meeting. However there will still be opportunity for the community to make additional project modifications based on community consensus. In the event there is significant change requested at the community meeting, the project may have to be re-presented to the Recreation and Park Commission

While the order of the meetings is unusual, the City Council is the final authority. When the construction contract is presented to the Council, the staff report will include information on the commissions and the community meeting.

We will be sending out more information on the September 17th meeting by the end of this week.
