You may be eligible for a Pfizer booster shot. Please see if you are among those recommended for the booster. Information on how you can get the shot is provided.



### **Pasadena Public Health Department Announces Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Clinics**

(Pasadena, CA.) - The Pasadena Public Health Department (PPHD) is administering Pfizer booster third doses in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) guidance for a booster dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine in several population groups. The CDC also recommended a booster dose for those in high risk occupational and institutional settings.

Boosters are currently only available to individuals who received Pfizer. Those who received Moderna and Johnson & Johnson will need to wait until the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and CDC review the data about boosters and determines the need for and safety of boosters for these vaccines.

Individuals who **SHOULD** receive a booster dose of Pfizer include those who received the second of the two-dose Pfizer vaccine series at least 6 months ago and are either:

- 65 years or older
- Residents of long-term care facilities
- 50 to 64 years with underlying medical conditions
- 

Certain other individuals **MAY** receive a booster dose of Pfizer if they received the second of the two-dose Pfizer vaccine series at least 6 months ago and are :

- 18 to 49 years with underlying medical conditions
- 18 to 64 years with high institutional or occupational risk, including healthcare workers, first responders, teachers and day care staff, grocery workers, and workers in homeless shelters or prisons.

The CDC advises that people can consult their physician to determine if they need a booster dose, and should assess their individual benefits and risks.

“We encourage eligible Pasadena residents to receive a booster dose of Pfizer vaccine at least 6 months after completing their initial 2-dose Pfizer series at one of many locations: through your own physician, a pharmacy or clinic, or at Pasadena Public Health Department clinics. PPHD will continue to work closely with our community to offer COVID-19 vaccine to those who are not yet vaccinated, in addition to providing booster doses.”

Those seeking Pfizer booster doses can make an appointment at [MyTurn.CA.gov](https://www.myturn.ca.gov) or by making an appointment at a pharmacy that offers Pfizer vaccinations. The PPHD will only offer booster vaccines by appointment only for those registered through the MyTurn system. For those who need assistance making an appointment, contact the Pasadena Citizen Service Center at (626) 744-7311, Monday-Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

PPHD will establish 3 drive-thru clinics for Pfizer booster doses by appointment only on Saturday, October 2, Tuesday, October 5, and Tuesday, October 12. Look for these clinics on [MyTurn.CA.gov](https://www.myturn.ca.gov) or contact the Citizen Service Center for assistance in registering.

Residents will need to bring proof that they have received two previous Pfizer doses, which for most people will be in the form of the white vaccination card, or a photo of the white card, or a digital record of your two doses. At all PPHD clinics, clients may be asked to sign an attestation form indicating they meet the criteria to receive the booster.
