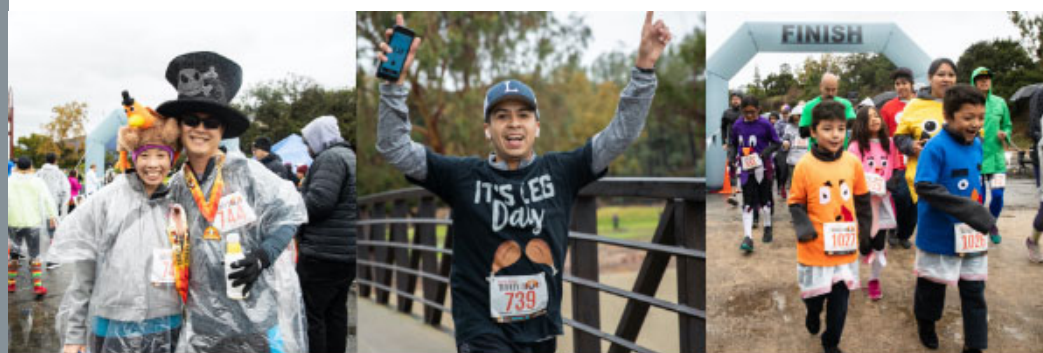

PASADENA, Calif. (November 4, 2021) The fourth annual Rose Bowl Turkey Trot continues to raise the bar by providing guests with two ways to participate this year. Runners, walkers, skippers, and jumpers alike can continue the tradition by running through Brookside Golf Course or from the comfort and safety of their favorite path.

Known for being a Pasadena family favorite and a Thanksgiving morning tradition, you won't want to miss it this year!

The Rose Bowl Stadium will be turning 100 in 2022 and as part of the year-long birthday celebration, each participant will receive a limited-edition commemorative pin.

Participants can either enter a timed, COVID-safe, in-person race at the Rose Bowl Stadium on Thanksgiving morning through a 3.1-mile course throughout the beautiful Brookside Golf Course or participate virtually. All participants will receive a race bib, medal and commemorative centennial pin.

For those who would rather join the virtual race, this can be done from anywhere in the world. This could be your neighborhood park, a local running trail, bike path quiet neighborhood street or wherever walking and running is safely permitted. All participants are encouraged to use the Race Joy app to track their official time and automatically send in their finish time as well as listen to some special messages from Rose Bowl Stadium legends during your trot.

To sign up for the 2021 Rose Bowl Turkey Trot, please visit www.rosebowlturkeytrot.com. Virtual tickets before November 5th are \$25.00 for under 18 and \$30.00 for ages 18 and older. Prices increase by \$5.00 on November 5th. In person tickets before November 5th are \$30 for adults 18 and older, \$25 for youth 10-17, and free for kids 9 and under. Prices increase by \$5 on November 5th for the adult and youth tickets.

The Rose Bowl Stadium is the proud home of the Tournament of Roses' Rose Bowl Game, UCLA Bruins football, AmericaFest Fourth of July Celebration, concerts including Kenny Chesney, Coldplay, Taylor Swift, and U2, international and Premier League soccer matches, and the World's Largest Flea Market.

A National Historic Landmark built in 1922 and known around the world, the Rose Bowl Stadium has earned its world-class reputation by hosting five NFL Super Bowl games, the 1984 Olympic Soccer matches, the 1994 Men's World Cup, the 1999 Women's World Cup, four BCS National College Football Championship Games and the College Football Playoff Semi-Final game.
