7. PUBLIC HEARING: SUBMITTAL OF REDISTRICTING TASK FORCE FINAL REPORT AND RECOMMENDED REDISTRICTING PLAN FOR CITY COUNCIL CONSIDERATION; RECEIVE PUBLIC INPUT AND TESTIMONY ON THE REDISTRICTING PLAN AND THE COMPOSITION OF ONE OR MORE COUNCIL DISTRICTS; AND CONCEPTUALLY APPROVE OR MODIFY THE RECOMMENDED REDISTRICTING PLAN

Recommendation of Redistricting Task Force: It is recommended that the City Council, as part of a public hearing process in compliance with California Elections Code Section 21627.1, take the following actions:

- (1) Find that the proposed action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), the Common Sense Exemption that CEQA only applies to projects that have the potential to have a significant effect on the environment;
- (2) Receive and review the Redistricting Task Force's recommended redistricting plan ("Redistricting Plan"), map, and related demographic data sheet (Attachment A - "Recommended Redistricting Plan approved October 30, 2021 by the Redistricting Task Force");
- (3) Receive public comment on the Redistricting Plan, and any public input/testimony regarding the composition of one or more council districts;
- (4) Conceptually approve the Redistricting Plan as submitted; or provide direction on requested modifications to the plan for further consideration; and
- (5) Continue the public hearing to each subsequent meeting of the City Council until December 6, 2021, or such other date as the City Council may determine, at which time the City Council will be asked to close the public hearing and conduct first reading of "An Ordinance of the City of Pasadena Amending Chapter 1.20 ("Election Districts") of the Pasadena Municipal Code"

codifying the Recommended Plan as submitted, or a modified Redistricting Plan as directed by the City Council.
