THIS HOLIDAY SEASON, DON'T PICK OUT THE PERFECT GIFT FOR THIEVES

Last year, an estimated 11 million Americans had packages stolen from their homes. Criminals target packages left unattended on doorsteps. Don't be the next victim! The Pasadena Police Department would like to remind citizens to take extra care this time of year when having mail and packages delivered to their residence.

Follow these simple steps to protect your holiday packages:

Track your package	Require a signature	Hold package @ mail facility	Be neighborly	Request a vacation hold
Track shipment information in advance. Many delivery companies offer customized alerts. UPS offers My Choice and FedEx offers Delivery Manager that give you some control on when and where packages arrive.	If you're shipping something of high value, or you just want to make sure items aren't left unattended, you can require a signature for packages to be released.	You can have your deliveries sent and held at a facility for pickup. For example, Amazon offers Amazon Locker, secure service lockers where customers pick up packages when it's convenient for them.	If you know you won't be home at the time of delivery, have someone you trust accept the package. If you live in a building, set up a way to have neighbors hold each others' packages rather than leave them in a common area.	If you are going to be on vacation during the time of your delivery, you can request a vacation hold on all shipments. For example, FedEx will hold your shipment for up to 14 days.

If your package gets stolen:

- Report the theft**
Contact your local law enforcement agency and file a report. Some agencies offer the convenient option of filing a report online.
- Contact the retailer**
Some retailers grant refunds on a case-by-case basis or replace items if the delivery has been confirmed by the delivery company.
- Check with your credit card company**
Some credit card companies offer protection for members who charge a covered purchase that ends up being stolen. Check with your company for specifics.
