Free Oil Filter Exchange Event on Saturday, April 3, 2021

PASADENA, Calif.— Do you change the oil yourself for your car or truck? All Pasadena do-it-yourselfers are invited to safely recycle both their used oil and oil filters—and get a new oil filter for free—from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., Saturday, April 3, 2021 at Pepboys, 1135 East Colorado Boulevard.

Just bring your used oil filter and get a free new oil filter, limited to three (3) per person. Free oil recycling kits will also be provided to attendees. Oil Filter Exchange Events help protect the environment by promoting proper recycling of used oil and oil filters.

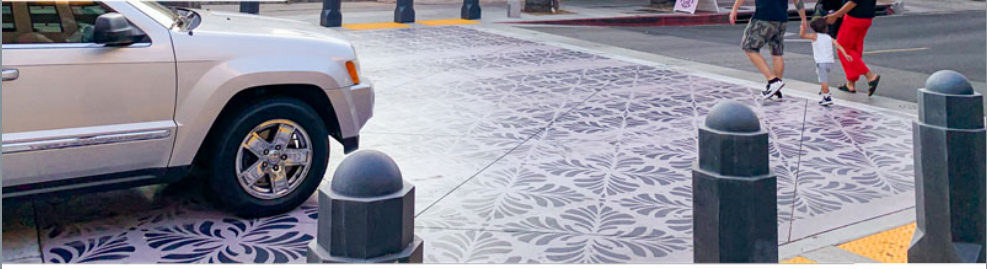
