Recreational activity will be closed beginning at 3:00 AM on Sunday, January 16th. The Equestrian Loop will remain open at all times.

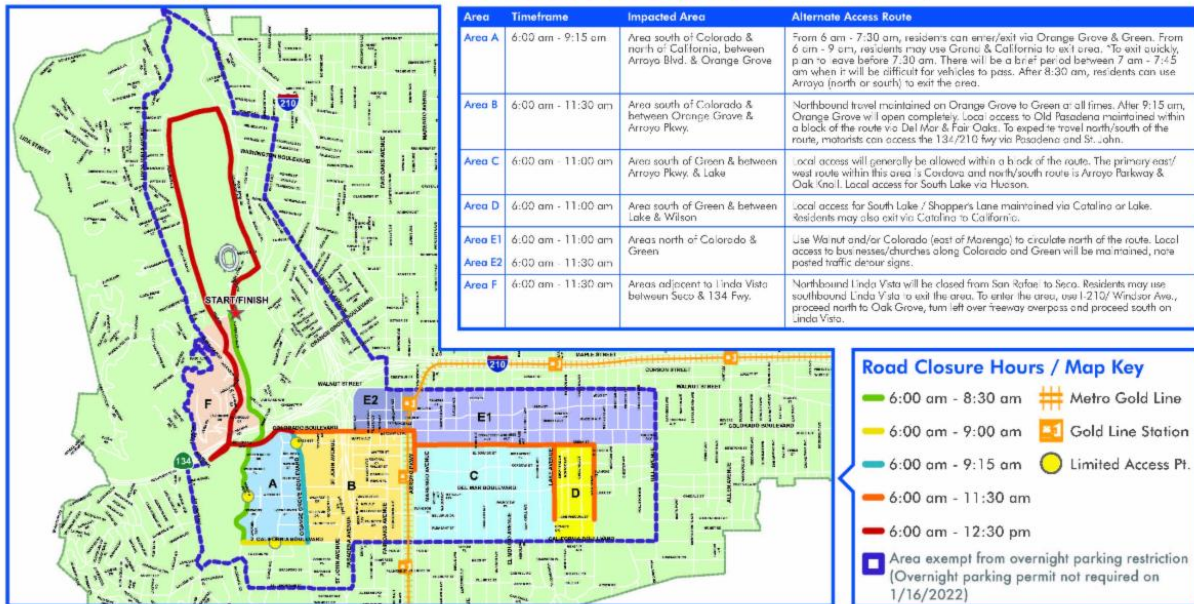
Overnight parking restrictions within a 1/4 mile off the route will be curtailed on Sunday, January 16th from 2:00 AM - 6:00 AM. During this time, overnight parking permits will not be required to park on City streets within the 1/4 mile radius area. All other parking restrictions and prohibitions will apply, including temporary tow away zones.

### Simplified Downtown Detour Information:

To expedite travel on event day, motorists are encouraged to use Walnut to the north, California to the south, Hill to the east or use the 710 extension to the west. During the race, only emergency vehicles will be permitted to cross the route, except at the designated intermittent traffic crossing points noted on the map.

### No Parking Zones:

Please adhere to all dates/times of the 'No Parking - Tow Away' signs along the course. Any cars parked along the course after 1:00 am on Sunday, January 16, 2022 will be towed. Overnight parking restrictions will be lifted within approximately 1/4 mile of the route, as highlighted on this map. During this time, overnight parking permits will NOT be required to park on city streets within the shaded area. All other parking restrictions and prohibitions will apply.
