District 6 Constituents,

PWP is planning to do some overnight work for the Arroyo Pipeline Project at Arroyo and Glenarm, June 27-30 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. There will be partial lane closures but a minimum of one lane in each direction will remain open to traffic. Traffic signage will be posted to minimize the impact of traffic flow along Arroyo Parkway. Details are in the attached construction notice.

Night Work Notification

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION TO THE RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF ARROYO PARKWAY FROM GLENARM STREET TO CORDOVA STREET

THE PROJECT

The Project will involve the installation of a new 12-inch diameter and a new 8-inch diameter water mainline in Arroyo Parkway from Glenarm Street to Cordova Street. The pipeline will increase the overall reliability and quality of water service in Pasadena.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Additional night work is required at the intersection of Arroyo Parkway and Glenarm Street. This work needs to be conducted at night due to requirements from the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). During construction, a variety of heavy equipment will be used including excavators, backhoes, loaders, and construction trucks. There will be partial lane closures but a minimum of one lane in each direction will remain open to traffic. Traffic signs and delineators will be employed to minimize the impact of traffic flow along Arroyo Parkway. Please observe and adhere to posted no parking zones, construction signs, and flagmen. Special efforts will be taken to keep inconveniences to a minimum.

TIME FRAMES

Night work will take place Monday-Thursday, 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., Monday, June 27 through Thursday, June 30. Once the night work is completed, the project will transition to its normal daytime schedule of Monday to Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
