District 6 Constituents,

Construction of the Union Cycle Track, which begins on June 28th, might disrupt your commute for a few weeks. Please note the time and the location of the work.



Union Street Two-Way Protected Bikeway (Cycle Track) Project Federal-Aid Project ATPCML-5064(089) In the City of Pasadena, California

The City of Pasadena and its Contractor, California Professional Engineering, Inc., will be constructing a 1.5 mile protected bicycle lane (cycle track) along Union Street from Hill Avenue to Arroyo Parkway, and a 0.3 mile bicycle boulevard along Holliston Avenue from Union Street to Cordova Street. Project consists of improvements at 14 signalized intersections, installation of six signalized intersections including equipment, conduit, fiber optic communications, audible pedestrian push buttons, ADA curb ramp upgrades, pavement resurfacing, curb and gutter repairs, striping and signage.

Typical work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and will be adjusted to accommodate traffic and pedestrian demands. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted where needed adjacent to work areas.

The City of Pasadena will do its best to minimize disruption caused by the construction. An Inspector from the City's Department of Public Works, wearing

a safety vest and a City identification badge, will be present on the job site to answer questions or provide assistance as needed.
