They will be turned off at the earliest possible time.

Noise Levels and Sound: These events will bring the usual impacts on the nearby neighborhoods such as traffic and noise. The noise level for these events will be primarily due to fan noise and residents can anticipate hearing noise associated with this event.

Traffic: Residents can anticipate heaviest traffic on Saturday, September 24th from 2:00 PM - 6:00 PM and again from 8:00 PM - 9:30 PM.
