**The Recreational Loop will be closed on Saturday, October 8th from
3:30 AM - 6:00 PM.**

The Equestrian Trail will remain open at all times.

Lighting Hours: Due to the event, including preparation and load-out, stadium lights will remain on for most of the evening into the early morning hours beginning Thursday, October 6 - Sunday, October 9th for safety and security purposes. They will be turned off at the earliest possible time.

Noise Levels and Sound: These events will bring the usual impacts on the nearby

neighborhoods such as traffic and noise. There will be use of pyrotechnics, as well as a 15 second air horn blown simultaneously to the pyrotechnics 60 minutes and 30 minutes prior to Kickoff (11:30 AM and 12:00 PM).

There will also be brief pyrotechnics when the team runs onto the field, during the National Anthem and anytime UCLA scores a touchdown. (Total pyrotechnics display may be heard for under 45 seconds).
