\*\*There will be a flyover prior to the start of the game conducted by the United States Marine Corps featuring four F-35 plans and four helicopters.

The Recreational Loop will be closed Saturday, November 19th from 12:00 AM - 11:59 PM.

The Equestrian Trail will remain open at all times.

**Lighting Hours:** Due to the event, including preparation and load-out, stadium lights will remain on for most of the evening into the early morning hours beginning Thursday, November 17th - Sunday, November 20th for safety and security purposes. They will be turned off at the earliest possible time.

**Noise Levels and Sound:** These events will bring the usual impacts on the nearby neighborhoods such as traffic and noise. There will be use of pyrotechnics, as well as a 15 second air horn blown simultaneously to the pyrotechnics 60 minutes and

30 minutes prior to Kickoff (4:00 PM and 4:30 PM).

There will also be brief pyrotechnics when the team runs onto the field, during the National Anthem and anytime UCLA scores a touchdown. (Total pyrotechnics display may be heard for under 45 seconds).

\*\*All times are approximate and are subject to change slightly.
