Our Covid-19 Safer at Home order is mandated through April 19th. Please continue to practice social distancing. Before leaving your home, ask yourself: Is this essential?

Beware of scams:

Beware of misinformation, price gouging, and scams connected to the coronavirus pandemic. Scams related to coronavirus can include:

- * Websites selling fake cures and safety gear.
- * Fake emails, texts and social media posts that spread false information about a cure in an attempt to get credit card and personal information, or to convince people to click on links that can infect their computers with malware.
- * Fake donation requests, which may come in the form of people asking for donations to help those impacted by coronavirus and needing donations only by cash or gift card.
- * Fake investment opportunities

We must also be on guard for products being sold at astronomical prices, otherwise known as price gouging.

If you or anyone you know has been the victim of price gouging or a coronavirus consumer scam, please contact the City Prosecutor's Office at (626) 744-4611 or the Pasadena Police Department at (626) 744-4241.

PUSD Meal Service:

The PUSD student "Grab and Go" meal service will extend to weekends starting March 28th and will expand to include meals for adults on these days. Pre-packed meals are available for pick up at seven PUSD schools from 9 - 11 a.m.

These meals are provided through special one-time funding by the City Council to address unforeseen and unmet food need for our PUSD students. The Rose Bowl and the Convention Center are both supporting this effort with logistical and staff support.

**Our local hospital needs blood and medical
supplies**

Medical supplies that the hospital is accepting are:

1. Medical masks (unused, unexpired medical masks, all kinds that are surgical or N95) - they are not accepting homemade masks at this time
2. Medical gloves (unopened, unused boxes only)
3. Paper medical gowns (unopened)
4. Hand sanitizer (unopened, unexpired only)
5. Disinfecting wipes (unopened, unused)

Public will be able to provide comments

In order to facilitate public participation at meetings held solely by electronic means, the City will accept public comment in the following manner:

Comments of any length may be submitted up to two hours prior to the start of the meeting at the following email address: publiccomment@cityofpasadena.net. Please be aware that, while these comments will be provided to the members of the body and will become part of the meeting record, they will not be read aloud. Any comment submitted in this fashion will be forwarded to the legislative body prior to the start of the meeting.

During the meeting, members of the public may submit up to 200 words regarding items on the agenda on the public comment form found here: <https://www.cityofpasadena.net/city-clerk/public-comment/>. If you wish your comments to be read aloud during the meeting, please indicate so on the form. If you submit more than one form, only the first one received will be read aloud. The City reserves the right to summarize comments if necessary for the orderly and timely flow of the meeting. All comments in their entirety will become part of the meeting record and will be forwarded to the legislative body.

US CENSUS INVITATIONS HAVE ARRIVED

Your response is important

While we all have distractions with the impact of Covid-19, it's critical to complete your census survey.

By now, you have probably received an invitation to **complete your census survey on line**. If you don't respond by April 8th, you will be sent a reminder letter and paper questionnaire.

The Census Bureau is required by law to protect any personal information. The answers provided on your questionnaire can only be used to produce statistics. The Census Bureau will NEVER ask you for your Social Security number, donations, or bank/credit card numbers.

Essential funding to our city depends on your survey. If you haven't already, please act now to complete it.
