## **PASADENA TEAMS UP WITH HUNTINGTON HOSPITAL FOR SEASONAL FLU VACCINES**

Beginning tomorrow, The Pasadena Public Health Department (PPHD) is partnering with Huntington Hospital to offer seasonal flu vaccines at no cost to anyone ages 6 months and older. The first event is a drive thru event at **Victory Park (2575 Paloma Street) Thursday, September 23, 2-6 p.m.**

At additional upcoming clinics, PPHD will also offer COVID-19 vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson) for those ages 12 years and older as well as flu shots:
