## **CLOSED FOR NOW:**

Personal care services (includes nail/hair salons, barbershops, cosmetology/skin care, tattoo & massage services), dog grooming/boarding, indoor and outdoor dining at restaurants and breweries, bars, movie theaters (except drive-in theaters), performance venues, museums & galleries, and offices for non-essential sectors.
