

## Notice of New Emergency Housing Voucher Availability

The City of Pasadena Housing Department (CoPHD) is pleased to announce that it has received 109 Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHVs) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). These new vouchers will help low-income households, both individuals and families, who are currently:

- Homeless;
- At risk of homelessness;
- Fleeing, or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking; or
- Recently homeless and for whom providing rental assistance will prevent the family's homelessness or having a high risk of housing instability.

The very low-income limit for Los Angeles County, which applies to the City of Pasadena, is as follows:

Family Size	1	2	3	4	5
Maximum Household Income	\$41,400	\$47,300	\$53,200	\$59,100	\$63,850

### How to Apply:

The CoPHD has partnered with the Pasadena Partnership to End Homelessness, which acts as the Continuum of Care for the City of Pasadena (Pasadena CoC) to ensure that EHVs assist eligible households who are most in need. The Pasadena CoC will refer households who are matched through the local Coordinated Entry System. The Coordinated Entry System is an existing system used by homeless service providers to connect people experiencing homelessness to housing and services.

The CoPHD is expected to begin accepting referrals on November 1, 2022.
