

PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE AVAILABILITY FOR REVIEW OF THE
PUBLIC HOUSING AGENCY (PHA) ANNUAL PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022
FOR THE CITY OF PASADENA HOUSING DEPARTMENT, AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC
HEARING TO CONSIDER ITS APPROVAL.

The City of Pasadena Housing Department (“CoPHD”) announces that the Public Housing Agency (PHA) 2022 Annual Plan (“2022 Annual Plan”) for the City of Pasadena will be considered at a public hearing on April 4, 2022, and is currently available for public review.

The Annual Plan, along with the Five-Year Plan, make up the PHA Plan. The current Five Year Plan covers the period of 2020-2025 and was adopted by City Council on October 5, 2020. The Annual Plan is submitted each year as part of the Five-Year Plan. The 2022 Annual Plan describes the CoPHD’s policies, programs, operations, and strategies for meeting local housing needs and goals for the upcoming fiscal year.
