## Visitor Pass Program for PPL Cardholders

The Huntington Library, Art Collections, and Botanical Gardens

March-August 2019 • Passes good for one week are available every Friday at Pasadena Central Library & La Pintoresca Branch

The Huntington Pass program with Pasadena Public Library allows a family of four (two adults and two children) free admission to The Huntington from March through August 2019. Passes are available every Friday morning; a pass allows one visit per family during that week. Two passes will be available at Pasadena Central Library and one will be available at the La Pintoresca Branch Library.

### Rules

1. Only ADULTS can pick up a PASS with a Pasadena Library Card
  - a. One PASS PER FAMILY (FAMILY of Four)
    - i. Two ADULTS, Two KIDS
2. Adult Patron must have Pasadena Library Card to PICK up the PASS.
3. Adults can only receive One PASS One time during the Six month period for one week as indicated on the PASS. A message should be placed on the Library Card note field that the Patron has received the PASS.
4. PASSES do not need to be returned.
5. PASSES are available on Fridays and cannot be reserved. The PASSES are available on a first come, first served basis.
6. Each PASS is good for one week, Friday – Thursday based on Calendar Dates.
7. There are Two PASSES at Central, One PASS at La Pintoresca. Once the PASSES are PICKED UP, they will not be available until the following Friday.
8. Staff is not required to call either location to see if PASSES are available.
9. Staff/Patrons cannot ask for PASSES to be placed on hold at either site.
