Whereas women play a critical economic, cultural and social role in every sphere of life in Pasadena; and

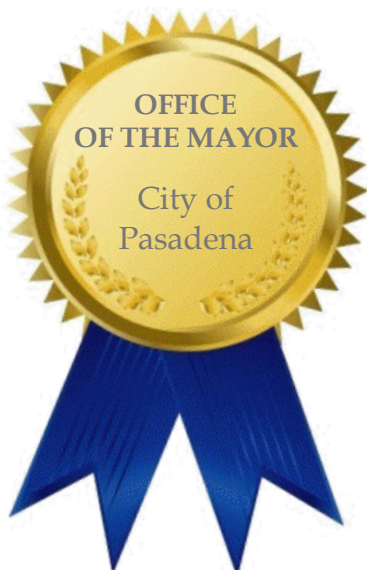
