PROCLAMATION

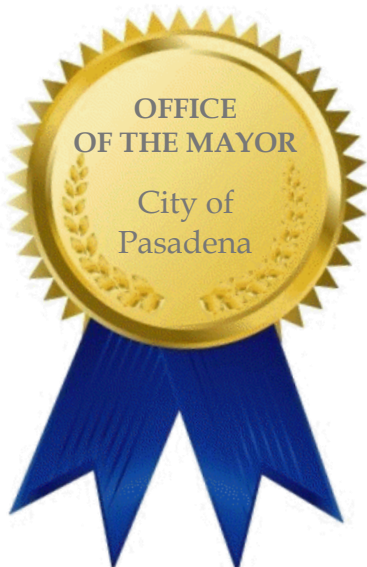


