PROCLAMATION


- Whereas* in Pasadena there are over 1,000 persons living in 12 nursing homes, and over 2,300 persons living in nearly 100 assisted living/residential care facilities; and
- Whereas* the Federal Nursing Home Reform Act of 1987 guarantees residents their individual rights in order to promote and maintain their dignity and autonomy, and all residents should be aware of their rights so that they may be empowered to live with dignity and self-determination; and
- Whereas* we wish to honor and celebrate these residents, recognize their rich individuality, and reaffirm their right to vote and participate politically, as well as their right to have a say in their own care; and
- Whereas* individuals and groups across the country will be celebrating Residents' Rights Month with the theme "*Inspiring Unity Within Our Community*" to highlight the need for residents' rights to be recognized, recovered and reasserted; and
