Funds will support the actors', director, and designer fees.
ACI	About Productions	\$ 10,000	\$ 6,200	5-Session <i>Young Theaterworks Pasadena: Through the Ages</i> - residencies at Rose City High School involving at-risk students collaborating with local elders and staff to create plays based on the elders' experiences. Students will learn and create art through sequential, free arts programming at Pintoresca Library. Project based workshops will teach basic hand tool skills to students at all levels of motor skills.
ACI	Ensemble Shakespeare	\$ 8,000	\$ 3,600	Grant will fund acting classes for community members with Parkinson's and other neurological conditions. " <i>The Shakes</i> ," will partner with professional actors and the company's director to create a devised theater piece for public performance. Public performances will be produced at Lineage.

Floricanto will also present one free 45-minute student outreach assembly at San Rafael Elementary School on Friday, May 1, 2020.

The event has a theme each month and includes live performances and demonstrations, take home art projects, and access to the museum's exhibits.
F&P	Light Bringer	\$ 10,000	\$ 7,000	<i>2020 Pasadena Chalk Festival</i> with chalk murals by more than 200 artists will take place on June 20-21, 2020 at Paseo Colorado.

F&P	LitFest Pasadena	\$ 10,000	\$ 6,200	Funding supports <i>LitFest</i> , a community literary festival that takes place in Pasadena's Playhouse District on May 16th and 17th, 2020. Litfest features 200 authors at 8 indoor and several outdoor venues at readings, panels, workshops, performances and other literary activities.
ACIII	Los Angeles Children's Chorus	\$ 10,000	\$ 4,500	Funding will support low-cost and free Pasadena-based classical, folk, contemporary, and world music children's choir concerts and activities including self-produced and expanded collaborative performances and free educational outreach.
ACIII	MUSE/IQUE	\$ 10,000	\$ 5,100	Funding supports <i>SHOES/FIT</i> , the first concert of our Uncorked series, on October 13, 2019 at the Rose Bowl. Using the joy of songs about where our feet and bodies have taken us, the organization's artistic director will lead the audience in remembering the places we've been, and imagining the places we can go.
ACI	Nancy Evans Dance	\$ 7,500	\$ 3,225	Funds will support performances celebrating the organization's 10th anniversary and include a free open rehearsal on Oct. 18, 2019, and 2-hour performances on October 19th, (evening) and October 20, 2019 (matinee), featuring live dance theatre with multi-media immersive storytelling, a Q & A with the dancers and choreographers. ACI	Oakwood Brass	\$ 10,000	\$ 5,100	Funding supports 19 <i>Instrument Introduction Concerts</i> for 4th graders at six PUSD elementary schools. Concerts will served an

				estimated 1,025 students.
ACI	Open Gate Theater	\$ 10,000	\$ 4,500	Funding supports three performances of <i>Dionysus in Hell</i> at the American Legion, with original text based on the Frogs by Aritophanes. Evening will also include free jazz, a solo noise/operatic set by Micaela Tobin and music by progressive rock band Diamonds.
ACII	Parson's Nose	\$ 10,000	\$ 5,100	Funding supports fifteen performances of <i>Imogen</i> , Artistic Director Lance Davis' reimagining of Shakespeare's Cymbeline in October and November 2019. Imogen will be the first fully staged production of this adaptation.
ACI	Pasadena Community Orchestra	\$ 9,838	\$ 4,427	Funding supports Pasadena Community Orchestra's <i>Young Artist Competition (YAC)</i> and concert, one of the highlights of the organization's season.
AEP	Pasadena Conservatory of Music	\$10,000	\$ 8,500	<i>Young Musicians Program</i> : 32 weeks of sequential, standards-based music curriculum for the 2019-20 school year for all pre-K to 5th grade students at Jefferson Elementary. Funds will support salaries for instructors.
ACI	Pasadena Master Chorale	\$ 10,000	\$ 5,100	Funding will support staff and artist salaries and composer-mentors for the program "Listening to the Future," which pairs composer-mentors with local youth to develop new choral pieces to be presented at a concert in Pasadena.
ACI	Pasadena Photography Arts	\$ 10,000	\$ 5,100	Funding will support a marketing consultant and the cost of rent and honoraria for two free, monthly programs: <i>Forum</i> and <i>Open Show</i> . These programs educate and showcase photographers working in the field.
ACIII	Pasadena Playhouse	\$ 10,000	\$ 6,200	To support the production of <i>The Great Leap</i> , by Lauren Yee, directed by Tony-winner and acclaimed Chinese American artist BD Wong. Approximately 600 free of charge tickets will be set aside for partnering nonprofits and local Title I schools through the theatrical access program <i>Community@Play</i> .
ACI	Pasadena Pro Musica	\$ 10,000	\$ 4,500	Award will support <i>Festival of Remembrance</i> , a choral concert that honors the diverse global traditions of autumn festivals such as Dia de los Muertos, All Souls Day, and Chuseuk, including a pre-concert talk and a post-concert reception featuring foods from the different communities. ProMusica plans collaboration with local cultural organizations

				to enhance the programming.
ACIII	Pasadena Symphony Association	\$ 6,857	\$ 4,800	Funding will support five (5) <i>Random Acts of Music</i> --interactive music events in unexpected public venues such as libraries, community centers, banks, shopping malls and schools featuring local, professional musicians.
ACIII	Red Hen Press	\$ 10,000	\$ 5,100	Funding will support literary outreach initiatives in Pasadena including three literary events and two series of free writing workshops for underserved students in the 2019–2020 program year.
ACI	Remainders	\$ 9,000	\$ 5,580	<i>Survey of 40 Women Artists from the 20th century</i> : an all-ages studio class series that will focus on the contribution of women artists in recent history. Participants will learn about a different notable female artist each week and create a work of art in her style. The work of a local female artist who draws inspiration from the featured artist will also be featured.
IA	Sehba Sarwar	\$ 5,000	\$ 2,550	Funding will support completion of artist's memoir and will include a performance and interactive artwork in Pasadena City College public space.
AEP	Side Street Projects	\$ 10,000	\$ 4,300	Funding will be used to teach PUSD students to plan, curate and produce <i>No Boundaries</i> , the PUSD district-wide art exhibition.
ACI	TA'YER	\$ 10,000	\$ 6,200	Funding is for <i>RUNAWASI-OUR HOME COMMUNITY THEATER AND WORKSHOPS</i> which provides a theater arts workshops and short plays exploring strategies to strengthen bonds among low-income families and to enhance the community and quality of life in neighborhoods of Northwest Pasadena.
