SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR FILM PERMITS Effective June 22, 2021

The City of Pasadena has revised the Film Office Guidelines to reflect the impact of COVID-19 on our community. All proposed film and photography applications must adhere to the City of Pasadena Public Health Order for Reducing COVID-19 Risk (attached) and conform to these Special Conditions.

- The production/applicant must comply with all Federal, State and local Public Health requirements.
- The film production company sector is still subject to the Cal OSHA Emergency Temporary Standards for worker protection, and the State Masking Order. Please see links below.
- Payment must be rendered before permit is issued.
- Please allow 5 business days lead time for permit processing. Lead-time includes prep, film, and strike activity.
- Student and non-profit filming as well as Still Photography are subject to the maximum number of Film Days per Quarter (six).
