Re: City of Pasadena Public Records Act Request dated July 8, 2019 - No. 11488

Dear Mr. Truitt:

As you are aware, the City of Pasadena has retained our office to respond to public records act requests. On August 2, 2019, I sent you a letter in response to your public records act request date July 8, 2019 that sought records pertaining to 11 separate categories. The letter referenced that some records were previously produced to you by the City on July 22, 2019 (roughly 494 records). In addition, the letter directed you to certain publicly available information listed on the City's website where you could obtain documents in response to your requests no. 2 , 5 and 9.

Contrary to your assertions, the City is diligently searching for all records that are responsive to the 11 categories of information that you seek. I am informed that there are more than 11,000 documents that are responsive to your request. The production schedule set forth in my August 2, 2019 letter was designed to ensure that you would have a steady stream of information available to you, while accounting for the fact that upwards of 11,000 documents must be reviewed and redacted for things such as attorney-client privileged communications, information which has an unreasonable impact on privacy, and other applicable exemptions under the public records act. To the extent that we can make records available to you sooner, we will do so.

Finally, your correspondence contains unsupported opinions and misstatements of fact and law, which do not require a further response.
