This is the same individual that received special help from your staff in vetting locations.

It remains to be seen if your staff conspired with McDonald to hide this location from the city council, public and other applicants by intentionally circulating a cannabis map they knew concealed this location.

You specifically promised me daily updates of CUP activity and you failed to disclose this for 8 days.

Your broken promises are denying me due process.

Are you or are you not going to provide daily updates?
