Dear Mr. Truitt:

As you are aware, the City of Pasadena ("City") has retained our firm to respond to Public Records Act requests. The City is in receipt of your public records act request dated Friday, August 23, 2019 seeking the following categories of information:

- "1) Please provide a printout of the PBX records (Call Detail Inquiry) for all city extensions assigned to Jennifer Paige for the period beginning September 1, 2018 through the date of production.
- 2) Please provide a printout of the PBX records (Call Detail Inquiry) for all city extensions assigned to David Reyes for the period beginning September 1, 2018 through the date of production.
- 3) For any cell phone used by Jennifer Paige used to sometimes conduct city business, any text messages or records of calls to or from the following numbers:

818-997-7949

480-536-5637
760-671-5647."

As was noted in my prior communication to you, there are no public documents responsive to category number 3. The City previously produced documents responsive to category number 1. Enclosed are documents responsive to category 2.

As you are aware, the Public Records Act permits a local agency to withhold from disclosure records that are exempt from disclosure, or portions of such records that are covered by an

exemption. (Cal. Gov. Code, § 6250 et seq.) The City is withholding records from disclosure, in part, pursuant to the following exemption: Attorney-client privileged communications are exempt from disclosure pursuant to California Evidence Code Section 954 (Cal. Gov. Code § 6254 (k)).

The City is in receipt of your communication regarding the incorrect filters being run for the phone records search and is searching to determine if there are any additional documents responsive to this request. If there are additional documents that are responsive, the City will make a further production.
