Does the City of Pasadena plan on making Harvest's hard copy CUP filing application available for public inspection?

If so, when?

It is supposed to be available at all times during office hours and I have been asking to inspect this document since July 17.

Your "diligent" city staff have refused to allow inspection or to advise me when I may inspect this document. If they believe redactions are required then they should make them and produce the redacted document for inspection.

In order to save everyone's time (which does not appear to be the goal of the city. the goal appears to be to refuse to cooperate with lawful requests while various deadlines run out) I suggest you consult with planning staff over what should and should not be redacted.

I suspect that staff is covering up omissions in Harvest's submissions by claiming the missing items are "redacted" when in fact they do not exist.

Excessive unlawful redactions will of course lead to more time wasting controversy.
