FIREARMS TRAINING TEAM

RANGE SAFETY BRIEF

1. Treat all firearms as if they are loaded.
2. Never point the muzzle at anything you are not willing to shoot or destroy
3. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are on target and ready to fire.
4. Keep the weapon on safe until you are ready to fire.
5. Be sure of the target, its backstop, and beyond.

COMMAND "CEASE FIRE" / MEDICAL EMERGENCY / OFFICER DOWN

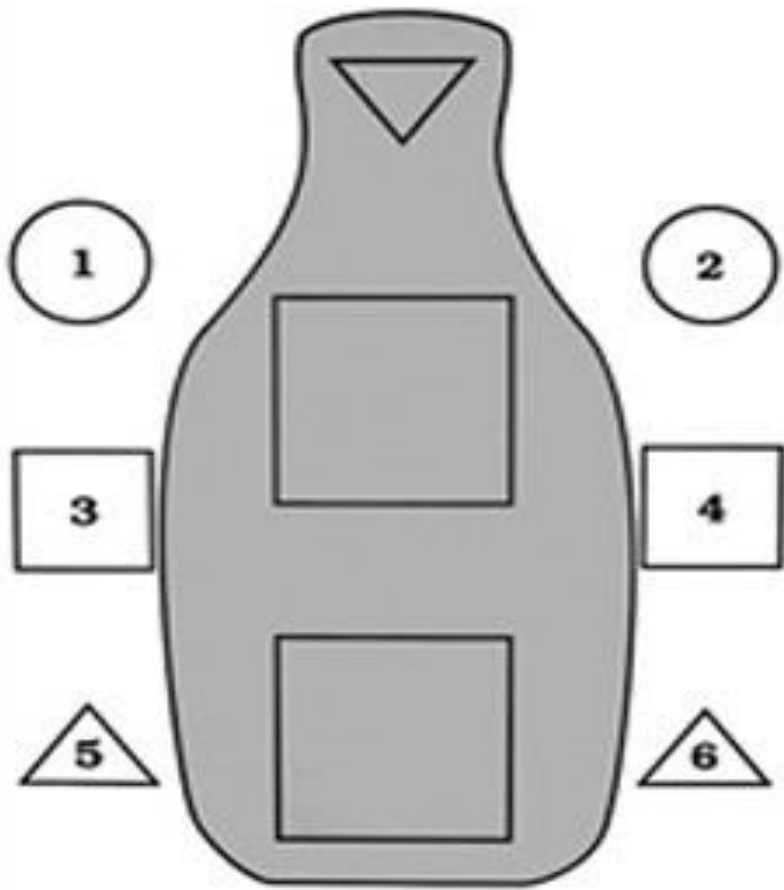
1. Call "Cease Fire." Stop shooting IMMEDIATELY.
2. Place your weapon on safe and holster weapon / put it away in safe direction.
3. Contact PFD and provide emergency medical care.
4. Tourniquet major bleeding on limbs / Chest Seal on chest & torso entry/exit wounds.
5. Designate roles to meet PFD / open gate and escort PFD to range.
6. Secure as crime scene

RIFLE COURSE OF FIRE

1	6	N/A	7 Yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• From the seven-yard line, Shooter will fire one round in each numbered shape on an SEB target, (1 and 2 circles, 3 and 4 squares, and 5 and 6 triangles).• 6 rounds• Shooter must then reload• Then move to second shooting position (15-yard line)
2	6	N/A	15 Yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• From the fifteen-yard line, Shooter will fire one round in each numbered shape on an SEB target, (1 and 2 circles, 3 and 4 squares, and 5 and 6 triangles).• 6 rounds• Then move to third shooting position (25-yard line)
3	4	N/A	25 Yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• From the 25-yard line, Shooter will fire 4 rounds at the head triangle of the SEB target• 4 rounds• Shooter will place weapon on safe, remove magazine, lock bolt the rear and show a clear weapon

This is a 16-round course, requiring two magazines to force a reload. The first magazine will be loaded with six rounds and the second magazine will have 10 rounds. All stages will be fired from a standing position. Make the shooter move tactically backwards.

This course allows the Officer to compensate for the offset of the optic versus the bore line of the rifle. Like October, this is a familiarization course of fire and will not be scored.
