RANGE SAFETY BRIEF

1. Treat all firearms as if they are loaded.
2. Never point the muzzle at anything you are not willing to shoot or destroy
3. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are on target and ready to fire.
4. Be sure of the target, its backstop, and beyond.

COMMAND “CEASE FIRE” / MEDICAL EMERGENCY / OFFICER DOWN

1. Call “Cease Fire.” Stop shooting IMMEDIATELY.
2. Place your weapon on safe and holster weapon / put it away in safe direction.
3. Contact PFD and provide emergency medical care.
4. Tourniquet major bleeding on limbs / Chest Seal on chest & torso entry/exit wounds.
5. Designate roles to meet PFD / open gate and escort PFD to range.
6. Secure as crime scene.

DUTY HANDGUN COURSE OF FIRE

- Ammunition: 45 rounds per shooter.
- Purpose: The course is designed for the officer to demonstrate their proficiency, accuracy, and gun manipulation.
- Target: “B8” or Bullseye style target (see attached)

Training Objectives: There will be two training objectives: Accuracy and safe weapon handling.

DRILL 1: Bullseye Qualification Course

30 rounds required for drill

Stage 1: 25-yard line

- On Command of gun / threat: Shooters will draw their pistol, engage the target with 10 rounds.

Stage 2: 15-yard line

- On Command of gun / threat: Shooters will draw their pistol, engage the target with 5 rounds.
- Repeat one additional time

Stage 3: 10-yard line

- On Command of gun threat: Shooters will draw their pistol, engage the target with 5 rounds.
- Repeat one additional time

Scoring: Any round outside the 10 ring, will be subtracted from 10. Minus 1 point in 9 ring, minus 2 points in 8 ring, etc. (similar to bluemax scoring)

Maximum score – 300, Minimum score of 240 (80%)

DRILL 2: 5x5x5

With an empty gun, Officers shall load 11 rounds in one magazine on the line. Officers shall have one additional magazine with 4 rounds.

Officers will be on the 5 yard for this drill. Officers should be told all rounds need to be inside the “X” ring. There is no time limit for any of the stages of fire.

Stage 1:

- On Command of gun / threat: Shooters will draw their pistol, engage the target with 5 rounds.

Stage 2:

- From the holster, on the command of gun / threat: Shooters will draw and fire one round into the target and reholster.
- Repeat for a total of 5 times on the command of gun / threat by the Range Master.

Stage 3:

- From the holster, on the command of gun / threat: Shooters will draw and fire one round into the target, conduct a slide lock reload, and fire four additional rounds

Scoring: Any round outside the 10 ring, will be subtracted from 10. Minus 1 point in 9 ring, minus 2 points in 8 ring, etc. (similar to bluemax scoring)

Maximum score of 150, minimum passing score of 120 (80%)
