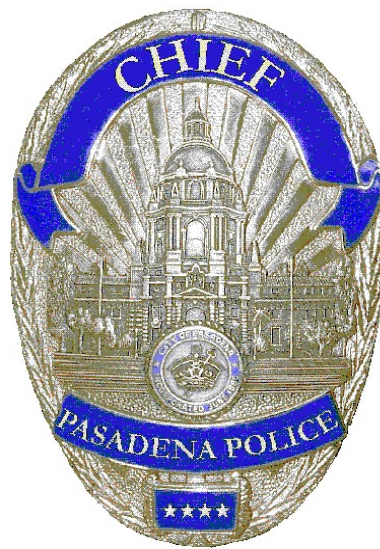

Rifle Course

Pre-shooting training points:

1. Basic overview of rifle

- a. Optic
 - i. Offset
 - ii. Brightness setting of optic
- b. Iron sights / alignment of sight
- c. Adjustable stock and sling
- d. Weapon Light
- e. charging handle / charging handle release
- f. forward assist assembly
- g. mag release
- h. safety switch

2. Patrol ready

- a. Set up patrol ready
- b. Demonstrate / practice

3. Manipulation

- a. Set / adjust stock
- b. Adjust optic brightness
- c. Magazine (load right side mag before left side mag)

4. Malfunctions

- a. Transition to handgun if rifle malfunction occurs / assess threat / fix rifle
- b. Stage one
 - i. Failure to feed
 - 1. Ensure rifle is in battery
 - 2. Rack the charging handle
- c. Stage two
 - i. Failure to eject
 - 1. Rack the charging handle
- d. Stage three
 - i. Double feed
 - 1. Remove mag
 - 2. Rack charging handle
 - 3. Re-insert mag

COURSE OF FIRE

RANGE SAFETY BRIEF

1. Treat all firearms as if they are loaded.
2. Never point the muzzle at anything you are not willing to shoot or destroy
3. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are on target and ready to fire.
4. Be sure of the target, its backstop, and beyond.

COMMAND "CEASE FIRE" / MEDICAL EMERGENCY / OFFICER DOWN

1. Call "Cease Fire." Stop shooting IMMEDIATELY.
2. Place your weapon on safe and holster weapon / put it away in safe direction.
3. Contact PFD and provide emergency medical care.
4. Tourniquet major bleeding on limbs / Chest Seal on chest & torso entry/exit wounds.
5. Designate roles to meet PFD / open gate and escort PFD to range.
6. Secure as crime scene.

RIFLE COURSE OF FIRE

- Ammunition: 20 rounds per shooter. (10 rounds first mag. / 10 rounds second mag.)
- Purpose: The course is designed for the officer to demonstrate their proficiency, accuracy, and gun manipulation.
- Target: One (1) "SEB" Targets (see attached)

Training Objectives: There will be two training objectives: Accuracy and safe weapon handling.

Rifle will be staged at the 50 yrd. line Shooter will make the rifle ready to begin the course.

50 yard line:

1. From the **PRONE POSITION** – 5 rounds top box.
2. Shooter will move to a blue barrel at the **25 YARD LINE**.

25 yard line:

1. From the **KNEELING POSITION** – 5 rounds top box
2. Shooter will reload behind cover (blue barrel).

Shooter will move to the 10 yard line **Graded 8 out of 10 rounds must hit torso.**

10 Yard Line:

1. From the **STANDING POSITION** – 1 round each shape (1,2,3,4,5,6) 1 round bottom box, 1 round top box, 2 rounds head triangle. (**10 Rounds**). Reenforce offset. **Not graded**

Shooter will then place the weapon on safe and evaluate the target with FTT Instructor.
