DECEASED INFANT FOUND IN LOCAL PARK FACILITY

Pasadena, CA – On Thursday, March 5, 2020 at approximately 10:10 PM Pasadena Police Officers responded to Memorial Park, located at 85 E. Holly Street, regarding a call of a possible lifeless infant located in a stall of the women's restroom. Officers and Pasadena Fire Paramedics arrived on scene, located and confirmed that the infant was deceased. Officers commenced canvassing the area for potential evidence and witnesses. Pasadena Police Detectives responded to the scene to continue with the investigation.

Maintenance staff made the discovery as they prepared to clean the restrooms, and immediately called the police department.

Los Angeles County Coroner Investigator responded to the scene and took custody of the infant.

The manner of death remains under investigation at this time. The infant was female and appears to have been of full term.
