Enhancing Neighborhood Safety

There are many ways you can be a vigilant citizen and keep your family, neighbors, and yourself safer. Crime can occur in any neighborhood, but there are means to reduce occurrences. Pasadena Police would like for you to consider the following safety tips:

- Report suspicious activity to your local law enforcement agency.
- Do not open the door to strangers. Do not assume by someone's appearance that they are safe.
- Keep your windows and doors closed AND locked at all times.
- If possible, first look through a window and respond to the "knock" by talking through the LOCKED door. By not responding, the person may assume no one is home and they may try to force entry.
- Be mindful that the person may not be alone and could be a distraction.
- Talk to your children about how to respond to strangers near the home.
- Install motion-sensor lights and security cameras inside and outside of your home.
- Consider starting a Neighborhood Watch group. Get to know your neighbors. Build relationships and a mutual understanding for safety in your community.
- Keep your vacation dates off social media.
