OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING SUSPECT IDENTIFIED

SUSPECT: LLOYD NELSON JR., MALE, 47 YEARS OLD

PASADENA, CA – On Friday, May 8, 2020, at approximately 3:35 p.m., Pasadena Police Department personnel exchanged gunfire with a suspect at the conclusion of a vehicle pursuit at the intersection of Corson Street and Allen Avenue, resulting in the death of the suspect and one officer sustaining a gunshot wound to the leg.

Detectives have now identified the suspect as Lloyd Nelson Jr, male, 47 years old, with his current residence unknown. In addition, Mr. Nelson's ties to the City of Pasadena remain unknown, as does his motive. Detectives continue to work around the clock on the investigation.

Detectives responded to the scene and immediately commenced an investigation, scouring the area for witnesses and evidence. Preliminarily, the investigation has revealed that the suspect shot at officers immediately at the conclusion of the vehicle pursuit, resulting in the exchange of gunfire and the suspect's ultimate death.

Violent encounters in our community will always have a significant impact on those involved and on those in the neighboring communities, as the loss of any life is difficult to understand. The Pasadena Police Department will continue to be transparent and provide details of the shooting as it is able to. Thank you for your continued support of the Pasadena Police Department as we wait for the outcomes of the criminal and administrative investigations, to include an investigation by the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office.
