COMPOSITE SKETCH OF SUSPECT INVOLVED IN HOMICIDE NEAR VILLA PARKE

PASADENA, CA – On Friday, November 13, 2020, at approximately 8:09 p.m., Pasadena Police Officers responded to the 200 block of Parke Street regarding a report of a shooting. Officers arrived on scene and located Victim Ernesto Jimenez. The 29-year-old victim sustained numerous gunshot wounds and was pronounced deceased at the scene.

On April 20, 2021, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors established a reward in the amount of \$10,000 in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the perpetrator(s) responsible for the murder of Ernesto Jimenez.

Through their investigative efforts, Pasadena Police Department Robbery/Homicide Detectives have developed detailed information on the possible identity of one suspect, which resulted in the attached composite sketch.



This murder suspect has been described as a Black male who has a dark complexion. He is approximately 25 to 30 years old, 5'11" to 6'01" tall, and 180 to 200 lbs.
