

**CITY OF PASADENA HEALTH OFFICER ORDER
FOR THE CONTROL OF COVID-19**

**SUPPLEMENT TO CITY OF PASADENA HEALTH OFFICER ORDER
FOR CONTROL OF COVID-19 Related to Infection Prevention and Control of
COVID-19 in Licensed Long-Term Care Facilities Issued on April 12, 2020**

This Order Issued: May 6, 2020

This Order is in effect until rescinded in writing by the Health Officer.

Please read this Order carefully. Violation of or failure to comply with this Order is a crime punishable by fine, imprisonment, or both. (California Health and Safety Code §120295.)

SUMMARY OF THE ORDER: This Health Officer Order (“Order”) requires all licensed long-term care facilities, including skilled nursing facilities (“SNF”) and assisted living facilities (“ALF”) to conduct COVID-19 Diagnostic Testing for Residents and Staff as outlined in this Order.

UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTIONS 120175 et seq., AND THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 8.04.010, THE CITY OF PASADENA HEALTH OFFICER ORDERS:

Effective immediately, the facility shall conduct COVID-19 diagnostic testing for patients/residents and staff, which may include those with and without symptoms, as requested or per guidance provided by the Pasadena Public Health Department (“PPHD”).

This Order applies to all persons within the City of Pasadena under the Health Officer’s jurisdiction.

Violation of this Order is a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment, fine or both under California Health and Safety Code Section 120295. This Revised Order will be enforced by the City of Pasadena Police Department, City Attorney/City Prosecutor’s Office, and/or any other agency designated by the Pasadena City Manager for enforcement.

If any subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Revised Order (or any other prior Order) or any application of it to any person, structure, gathering, or circumstance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of a court of

competent jurisdiction, then such decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Revised Order (or any other prior Order).
