ORDINANCE NO. 7366

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING TITLE 6, CHAPTER 6.16 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TO ELIMINATE DOG LICENSE FEE PRORATION

The People of the City of Pasadena ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Title 6, Chapter 6.16, Section 6.16.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“The city assessor, tax and license collector of Pasadena is hereby authorized and directed to procure each year such number of license certificates and tags as may be sufficient for use during the year, with the year plainly inscribed thereon. The certificates and tags shall be effective from the issuance of the license until and including the final day the license is valid , and no longer.”

SECTION 2. Title 6, Chapter 6.16, Section 6.16.050 B. is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following text:

“B. Reserved.”

SECTION 3. Title 6, Chapter 6.16, Section 6.16.060 A. is hereby amended to read as follows:

“A. Licenses shall be renewed and the fees due and payable within one month of the expiration of the license. In addition to the license fee thereafter collected upon the issuance of a renewal permit, there shall be charged a penalty.”

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published as provided by the City Charter.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.



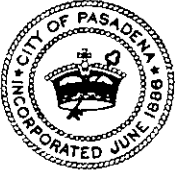

SUBJECT: DOG LICENSE REGULATIONS

TITLE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PASADENA AMENDING TITLE 6, CHAPTER 6.16 OF THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CODE TO ELIMINATE DOG LICENSE FEE PRORATION

PURPOSE OF THE ORDINANCE:

The Pasadena Humane Society ("PHS") is the City's poundmaster. PHS has requested that the City simplify its dog license fee structure by removing proration, which is currently required by PMC 6.16.050.B. Removing proration would allow the City's residents to purchase dog licenses online using PHS's new online purchasing platform. According to PHS, the new platform would only accommodate a prorated fee structure with the purchase of an additional module, which would make online transactions less cost effective.

REASONS WHY LEGISLATION IS NEEDED:

On June 22, 2020 the City Council directed the City Attorney to amend Chapter 6.16 of the Pasadena Municipal Code to eliminate dog license fee proration.

PROGRAMS, DEPARTMENTS OR GROUPS AFFECTED:

Dog license customers will pay the fees set forth in this ordinance. The poundmaster will be responsible for the administrative implementation of the new fees.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The proposed action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") in accordance with Section 15061(b)(3). The Common Sense Exemption states that CEQA only applies to projects that may have an effect on the environment.

"A. Licenses shall be renewed and the fees due and payable within one month of the expiration of the license. ~~July 1st of each year. No penalty shall attach if the license fee shall be paid prior to September 1st.~~ In addition to the license fee thereafter collected upon the issuance of a renewal permit, there shall be charged a penalty."

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published as provided by the City Charter.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.




