


ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

On May 6, 2024, the Council found that this ordinance is not a project as defined in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Public Resources Code Section 21065, 21080(b)(8) and State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15378(a) and (b)(4), and that even if it were a project, the proposed sewer use fee increases are statutorily exempt pursuant to Section 15273 (Rates, Tolls, Fares, and Charges) under State CEQA Guidelines and as such, is not subject to environmental review.


FISCAL IMPACT:

The City adopted revised sewer use rates, which is anticipated to generate an additional \$3.9 million in revenue in FY 2025 to address the cost of service and to start building reserves. There is no direct fiscal impact of amending this ordinance to implement the new rates.

B. The city council may, from time to time, amend fees for sanitary sewerage system service by resolution. For all properties served by the city sanitary sewerage system and not under "the water rate ordinance," the following charges shall be made:

1. For all 1, 2, and 3 family units—\$0.15 / 100 cu. ft. minimum \$4.76 per month.
2. For all other service—\$0.22 / 100 cu. ft.

C. All water introduced into the city sewers from customers not subject to the water rate ordinance any other source including private wells or rain water will be estimated and subjected to this same charge. No charge shall be made or collected on monthly bills where no portion of the water metered goes into the sanitary sewerage system.

D. The fee schedule will be indexed on an annual basis in accordance with the Consumer Price Index for the Los Angeles/Anaheim/Riverside area."

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this ordinance to be published in full text.

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SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
