CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

Franchisees are required to pick up Christmas trees per your franchise agreement. Please inform your customers about your company's holiday tree collection/recycling options and ask their support in properly disposing of Christmas trees. In January 2018, we will request information on the number of Christmas trees each franchisee collects from Pasadena.

FRANCHISE AUDITS

It is that time of the year again that the City selects franchises to be audited for the time period of January 2016 through December 2016. As required by your franchise agreement, keep all records in order, in case you are selected to be audited. In addition, if you are working with a subcontractor/broker, please inform the auditor during the audit process.

ORGANICS RECYCLING REQUIREMENT (AB 1826)

The following six franchise haulers are recycling organics for some of their customers and have sent the City a list of their customers. If your name is not on the list below and you are collecting organics for some of your customers, please let us know.

PASADENA CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION PROJECTS

As a reminder, Pasadena Municipal Code 8.62 requires recycling a minimum of 75% of the debris generated from construction and demolition (C&D) projects. If you own a facility and process materials from a construction and demolition project in Pasadena, please make sure you provide your customers weight/disposal tickets indicating the material achieved 75% diversion or higher, otherwise, the City of Pasadena may forfeit the security deposit, which may be as much as \$30,000 dollars. Attached is a list of City of Los Angeles certified construction and demolition facilities. Please check the link below for a current list as it is updated from time to time. INERT DEBRIS ENG FILL OPERATION FACILITIES

Per CalRecycle, if a facility is in the notification tier, the facility's disposal does not count towards a jurisdiction's disposal total. If the activity is listed as "Inert Debris ENG Fill Operation" and the regulatory status is listed as "Notification", the reporting for materials taken to these facilities would count as neither disposal nor diversion-in essence a WASH. Attached is a list of these facilities. Keep in mind that CalRecycle is constantly making changes, so please check the list on a regular basis on the website below:

EMISSION STANDARDS REMINDER

Per South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Rule 1193, franchisees with 15 or more solid waste collection vehicles used in Pasadena (collection, roll-off & transfer vehicles) must use 100% alternative-fuel vehicles no later than 5 years from the date of contract service; minimum replacement percentage are phased: For more information on vehicle rule 1993, please visit: https://www.arb.ca.gov/drdb/sc/suphtml/1193_s_06-06-03.pdf

Minimum Percentage	Deadline
20%	By July 1, 2014
40%	By July 1, 2015
60%	By July 1, 2016
80%	By July 1, 2017
100%	By July 1, 2018
