Retrofit and Rehabilitation

Project Description

- The La Loma Bridge Project is a collaborative effort between the City of Pasadena and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans)
- Will retrofit and rehabilitate the historic neoclassical revival design bridge that spans the Arroyo Seco

Project Improvements

- Replacement and widening of the bridge deck by one foot on each side to meet federal design standards
- Rehabilitation of arches and spandrel columns to restore the overall appearance of the bridge
- Strengthening of the end piers
- Historic decorative railing and streetlights

Project Timeline

- Construction Mobilization Date: June 2015
- Bridge Closure Date: July 2015
