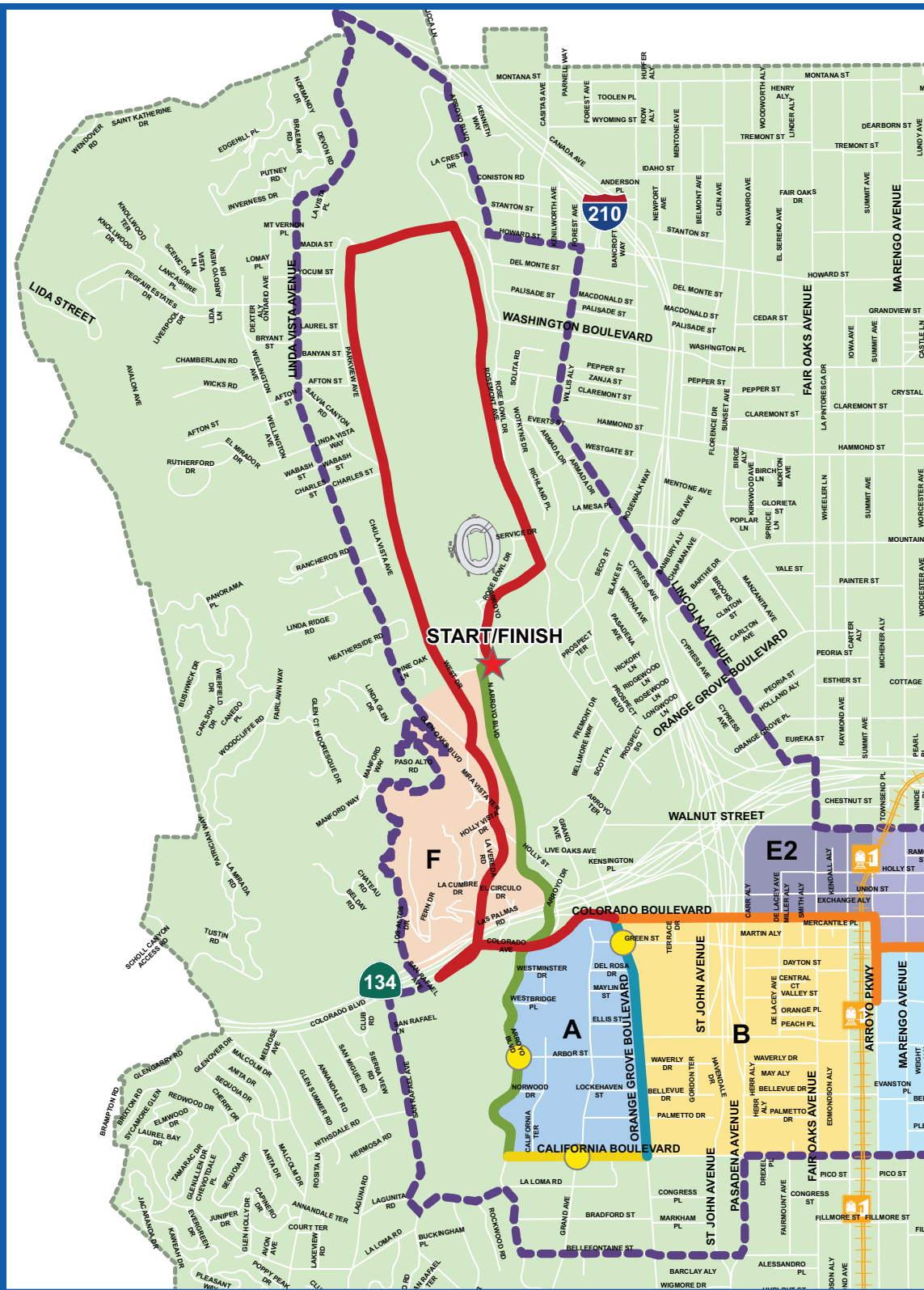


2024 ROSE BOWL HALF MARATHON PUBLIC ACCESS MAP • SUNDAY, JANUARY 21, 2024



Area	Timeframe	Impacted Area	Alternate Access Route
Area A	6:00 am - 9:15 am	Area south of Colorado & north of California, between Arroyo Blvd. & Orange Grove	From 6 am - 7:30 am, residents can enter/exit via Orange Grove & Green. From 6 am - 9 am, residents may use Grand & California to exit area. *To exit quickly, plan to leave before 7:30 am. There will be a brief period between 7 am - 7:45 am when it will be difficult for vehicles to pass. After 8:30 am, residents can use Arroyo (north or south) to exit the area.
Area B	6:00 am - 11:30 am	Area south of Colorado & between Orange Grove & Arroyo Pkwy.	Northbound travel maintained on Orange Grove to Green at all times. After 9:15 am, Orange Grove will open completely. Local access to Old Pasadena maintained within a block of the route via Del Mar & Fair Oaks. To expedite travel north/south of the route, motorists can access the 134/210 fwy via Pasadena and St. John.
Area C	6:00 am - 11:00 am	Area south of Green & between Arroyo Pkwy. & Lake	Local access will generally be allowed within a block of the route. The primary east/west route within this area is Cordova and north/south route is Arroyo Parkway & Oak Knoll. Local access for South Lake via Hudson.
Area D	6:00 am - 11:00 am	Area south of Green & between Lake & Wilson	Local access for South Lake / Shopper's Lane maintained via Catalina or Lake. Residents may also exit via Catalina to California.
Area E1	6:00 am - 11:00 am	Areas north of Colorado & Green	Use Walnut and/or Colorado (east of Marengo) to circulate north of the route. Local access to businesses/churches along Colorado and Green will be maintained, note posted traffic detour signs.
Area E2	6:00 am - 11:30 am	Areas north of Colorado & Green	Use Walnut and/or Colorado (east of Marengo) to circulate north of the route. Local access to businesses/churches along Colorado and Green will be maintained, note posted traffic detour signs.
Area F	6:00 am - 11:30 am	Areas adjacent to Linda Vista between Seco & 134 Fwy.	Northbound Linda Vista will be closed from San Rafael to Seco. Residents may use southbound Linda Vista to exit the area. To enter the area, use I-210/ Windsor Ave., proceed north to Oak Grove, turn left over freeway overpass and proceed south on Linda Vista.

Simplified Downtown Detour Information:

To expedite travel on event day, motorists are encouraged to use Walnut to the north, California to the south, Hill to the east or use the 710 extension to the west. During the race, only emergency vehicles will be permitted to cross the route, except at the designated intermittent traffic crossing points noted on the map.

No Parking Zones:

Please adhere to all dates/times of the "No Parking-Tow Away" signs along the course. Any cars parked along the course after 1:00 am on Sunday, January 21, 2024 will be towed. Overnight parking restrictions will be lifted within approximately 1/4 mile of the route, as highlighted on this map. During this time, overnight parking permits will NOT be required to park on city streets within the shaded area. All other parking restrictions and prohibitions will apply.
