Preliminary Design Work Begins in 2021!

The City of Pasadena's Department of Transportation developed the Citywide Complete Streets Program to address resident concerns through the implementation of traffic-calming measures on local streets. This program provides a comprehensive process for managing traffic volume, travel speeds and traffic-related noise in the City's residential neighborhoods.

In 2014, the City identified the Avenue 64 Corridor between Colorado Boulevard and the south city limit as an area eligible to benefit from the Citywide Complete Streets Program. Through the efforts of the San Rafael Area Complete Streets Working Group and with the support of the residents the Department of Transportation recommended the installation of a roundabout at the intersection of Avenue 64 at Burleigh Drive and traffic calming bulb outs at the intersection of Avenue 64 at Cheviotdale Drive. In December 2020, the City contracted GHD to provide professional engineering services to develop a design these traffic calming measures along the Avenue 64 corridor.

What Can I Expect?

As part of the Avenue 64 Complete Street Project preliminary design, GHD will begin locating utilities along the corridor and conducting field activities to support development of topographic and right-of-way maps, a traffic analysis, and a geotechnical investigation. These field activities are expected to begin in January 2021 and be completed by the end of March 2021. You can expect to see work zones associated with these field activities as described below and depicted on the project area map included with this notice.

Geotechnical investigation activities will occur within the rights-of-way of Avenue 64 at two intersections during the week of January 18, 2021: Avenue 64 at Cheviotdale Drive & Avenue 64 at Burleigh Drive

Geotechnical investigation activities will occur within the rights-of-way of Avenue 64 at two intersections: Avenue 64 at Cheviotdale Drive and Avenue 64 at Burleigh Drive. Contractors will use truck-mounted equipment to obtain pavement and subsurface soil samples and perform percolation testing. This activity may create noise and impact traffic in the immediate vicinity of these locations for two days the week of January 18, 2021.

There will be traffic lane restrictions associated with these field activities; however, the contractor will maintain access for residents, businesses, and emergency vehicles at all times. Please note that individual driveways may be restricted occasionally, between the work hours of 9 AM and 4 PM. On-street parking will not be allowed in the work zones. In addition, please do not remove any barricades or traffic signs that may be in place for your safety and protection.

What's Next?


