ATTENTION PERMIT APPLICANT

PERMIT REQUIRED

Under Pasadena Municipal Code (Section 10.44.010) it is unlawful for the owner or driver of any vehicle to allow such vehicle to remain standing in any street or alley in the City between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. without a permit.

INVESTIGATION REQUIRED

The Director of Transportation shall conduct an investigation to determine (1) that adequate off-street parking is not available within 600 feet of the applicant's residence and (2) that no public safety problem will result in the issuance of this permit. If the application is for daytime parking, the applicant must have a current annual city all-night street parking permit or a parking district all-night parking permit issued for the vehicle specified in the application. (P.M.C. 10.42.050)

DENIAL

Your application for a parking permit may be denied for one of the following reasons:

1. All parking at residence shall be used for parking drivable vehicles. Storage in parking spaces shall be cause for denial.
2. If there is adequate room to park all vehicles on the premises, the application will be denied.
3. If parking is available, either free or paid, within 600 feet of your residence, the application will be denied.
4. All vehicles at your residence, including those for which parking permits are not applied for, must be currently registered at the location
5. Application for a permit for a vehicle used for business purposes may be denied.
6. If two permits of the same type are currently issued to your residence, application for an additional permit will be denied.
7. If there are outstanding parking citations issued to any vehicle at the residence.

RIGHT TO APPEAL

Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Director of Transportation with reference to the approval or denial of an application for a permit or renewal of a permit or suspension of a permit shall have the right of appeal. An appeal must be perfected within 15 days after notice of the decision or order of suspension by filing with the City Manager a Letter of Appeal briefly stating therein the basis for the appeal. Applicants need to correspond directly with the City Manager's office in writing.

DISPLAY OF PERMIT

The permit shall be visibly affixed to the inside left rear side window of the vehicle for which it is issued, and the permit shall not be effective unless it is so affixed. (P.M.C. 10.42.080 and P.M.C. 10.44.070)

MAXIMUM NUMBER

No more than 2 nighttime and 2 daytime on-street parking permits shall be issued to one residence at any time. (P.M.C. 10.42.060)

PERMIT VALID

Vehicle shall be parked on any street within a 500 foot radius of a permittee's place of residence as designated on permit.

Under the following circumstances, a permit shall be invalid:

1. On any street where parking is prohibited either by red curb or posted parking prohibitions during the hours such prohibitions are in effect; (This includes posted restrictions for street sweeping)
2. In any green, yellow, blue or white painted curb zone; or
3. On any street in front or abutting any property except property improved exclusively for residential use. (P.M.C. 10.42.060)

SEVENTY-TWO HOUR LIMIT

No vehicle for which a permit has been issued shall be parked or left standing upon any street or alley for a period of more than 72 consecutive hours. (P.M.C. 10.42.160 and P.M.C. 10.44.140)

CHANGE OF ADDRESS/VEHICLE

Permittee must return the current permit and reapply. Verification of the circumstances under which the original permit was issued will be made. Once verified, a new permit will be issued upon receipt of payment of transfer fee and/or duplicate fee.

TEMPORARY PERMITS

A thirty-day permit is available for purchase for a temporary need for on-street parking. Renewal of the temporary permit for an additional thirty days will require an investigation and approval from the Director of Transportation.
