

# Great Plates Delivered: Home Meals for Older Adults

On April 24, 2020, Governor Gavin Newsom announced the launch of a first-in-the-nation "Great Plates Delivered" program, a meal delivery service for California's older adults.

## Great Plates Delivered has two purposes:

1. Help older adults and adults at high risk from COVID-19 to stay home and stay healthy by delivering three nutritious meals a day.
2. Provide essential economic stimulus to local businesses to stay afloat during the COVID-19 crisis.

## Who qualifies for enrollment into the program?

- Individuals who are 65 or older
- Individuals who are 60-64 years old and at high risk as defined by the CDC, including:
  - Are COVID-19 positive (as documented by a state/local public health official or medical health professional)
  - Have been exposed to COVID-19 (as documented by a state/local public health official or medical health professional)
  - Have an underlying condition
- Individuals must live alone or with one other program-eligible adult
- Participants must not be currently receiving assistance from other state or federal nutrition assistance programs such as CalFresh or Meals on Wheels
- Household income for one person cannot exceed \$74,940 or \$101,460 for a household of two
- Individuals must affirm an inability to prepare or obtain meals
