### HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

**PASADENA, CA** –On Saturday, April 1, 2017 at approximately 10:09 pm., Pasadena Police Department officers on patrol in the 200 block of W. Washington Boulevard were flagged down by a citizen who said a person had been shot inside a nearby residence. Officers located and made entry into a residence in the 200 block of W. Washington Boulevard and found a 37 year-old woman suffering from a gunshot wound.

Pasadena Fire Department personnel arrived and pronounced the victim dead at the scene. Investigation revealed that 59 year-old Andrew Moore and 63 year-old Felipe More had been involved in an argument at the home, at which both are residents. The two men are not related. During the argument, both Moore and More armed themselves with handguns. More fired his handgun, striking the 37 year-old woman. As a result of the investigation, both Moore and More were arrested for murder. The handguns used in the incident were recovered at the scene.

The identity of the victim is being withheld pending notification of next of kin.
