ADULT MALE KILLED AND ANOTHER CRITICAL IN EARLY MORNING STABBING

PASADENA, CA – On Wednesday, September 12, 2018, at approximately 1:30AM, Pasadena Police officers responded to the 2600 block of East Colorado Blvd. regarding a report of a stabbing that occurred on the sidewalk. Upon arrival, officers located two victims suffering from stab wounds. A witness on scene detain the alleged suspect, identified only at this time as a male adult 66 years of age. Officers immediately took the custody of the suspect.

Victim #1, an adult male in his 40's, was found unresponsive on the sidewalk suffering from stab wounds to the torso. Pasadena Fire/Paramedics immediately commenced life-saving efforts as they transported him to a local hospital. Life-saving efforts continued but victim #1 succumbed to his injuries.

Victim #2, a male adult in his 30's, was found with a large knife impaled into his leg. The victim was also transported to a local area hospital where he remains in critical condition.

The victims' identity is withheld pending next of kin notifications.

Pasadena Police Detectives responded to the scene for investigation. Preliminary information revealed there was some type of verbal exchange between the victims and the suspect. The suspect left but returned a short time later armed with a knife and stabbed both victims. The motive for the attack remains unclear at this time. The suspect remains in police custody at this time, as the investigation continues.
