COMPOSTING HAULERS

Effective, August 23, 2015, the Solid Waste and Collection Franchise System Ordinance #7264 in Chapter 8.61 of the Pasadena Municipal Code was amended. The amended ordinance allows new haulers that collect, transport, dispose and recycle in the City of Pasadena organic material to a compost facility to apply for a franchise and collect specified materials from both commercial entities and single family residences.

ASSEMBLY BILL 1826 (CHESBRO)

REMINDER!

In October 2014 Governor Brown signed AB 1826 Chesbro (Chapter 727, Statutes of 2014), requiring businesses to recycle their organic waste on or after April 1, 2016, depending on the amount of waste they generate per week. Currently 8 cubic yards of organic waste in 2016, and 4 cubic yards in 2017, with a final goal of 1 cubic yard in 2019. This law also requires that by 2016, local jurisdictions across the state implement an organic waste recycling program to divert organic waste generated by businesses, including multifamily residential dwellings that consist of five or more units. Organic waste means; food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, non-hazardous wood waste, and food-soiled paper waste that is mixed in with food waste. For more information please go to:

Implementation Dates:

January 1, 2016: Local jurisdictions must have an organic waste recycling program in place.

April 1, 2016: Businesses that generate 8 cubic yards of organic waste per week, must arrange for organic waste recycling services.

January 1, 2017: Businesses that generate 4 cubic yards of organic waste per week, must arrange for organic waste recycling services.

August 1, 2017 and Ongoing: Jurisdictions shall provide information about their organic waste recycling program implementation in the annual report submitted to CalRecycle.

January 1, 2019: Businesses that generate 4 cubic yards or more of commercial solid waste per week must arrange for organic waste recycling services.

Summer/Fall 2021: If CalRecycle determines that the statewide disposal of organic waste in 2020 has not been reduced by 50 percent of the level of disposal during 2014, the organic recycling requirements on businesses will expand to cover businesses that generate two cubic yards or more of commercial solid waste per week.

**INERT DEBRIS ENG FILL
OPERATION FACILITIES**

Per CalRecycle, if a facility is in the notification tier, the facility's disposal does not count towards a jurisdiction's disposal total. If the activity is listed as "Inert Debris ENG Fill Operation" and the regulatory status is listed as "Notification", the reporting for materials taken to these facilities would count as neither disposal nor diversion - in essence a WASH. Below is a current list of these facilities. Keep in mind that CalRecycle is constantly making changes, so please check the list on a regular basis on the website below:
