California Public Records Act requests are not required to be in an email, or submitted to the city's PRA system or even be in writing.

A public records request may be made in writing or orally, in person or by phone. Further, a written request may be made in paper or electronic form and may be mailed, emailed, faxed, or personally delivered. (Los Angeles Times v. Alameda Corridor Transportation Authority (2001) 88 Cal.App.4th 1381, 1392)

You cannot require requests be made in writing using a particular form or procedure.
