On July 20, 2019 I notified you that the city had failed to produce or make a determination on certain of my public records act requests issued July 9 for copies of among other things:

- 1) the Sweetflower CUP application filed July 3
- 2) copies of the code compliance section for the Harvest CUP application sent by email on June 12

It has now been 17 days since I made these requests and the city has produced nothing, not even the statutorily required 10-day determination.

On July 17 (9 days ago) I requested to inspect the hard copy of the CUP application filed by Harvest of Pasadena LLC on July 16. I have received no response even though these records are supposed to be available for inspection "at all times" during office hours. How can the city continue to process a CUP application that it refuses to show to the public?

The City is interfering with my California Constitutional Right to participate in this process.

I urge you to remove these documents from the custody and control of Guillermina Nunez and produce them promptly for inspection.
